



PRIVACY AND PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY

In this Policy you will find the relevant information applicable to the use of the personal data you provide to us, regardless of the channel (online or in person) you use. Please read this policy carefully because when you provide us your personal information, you are agreeing with it. We may occasionally make changes to this policy, so please be sure to read it again from time to time.

Our Privacy and Personal Data Protection Policy covers all data collection actions in the several project activities and informs how we act to ensure the security of all personal data in accordance with the legislation in force.

WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?

TWOST Project Consortium collects the following data:

- personal identification information (name of organization, type of organization, address of organization, country of origin)
- data of contact person

HOW DO WE COLLECT YOUR DATA

You directly provide TWOST Project Consortium with the data we collect when you:

- register online on twost website;
- voluntarily complete a survey or provide feedback on any mail.

HOW WE USE YOUR DATA?

Such data must be processed by the “TWOST” Project Consortium solely for implementing, managing, monitoring and disseminating the “TWOST” Project and for reporting procedures to the European Commission for project financing and monitoring, including checks, audits and investigations, without prejudice to possible transmission to the bodies charged with the monitoring or inspection tasks in application of national laws.

If you agree, such data can be processed for networking purposes and stored in the database of the consortium in order to involve possible partners into the future projects. Your email will be inserted in the network to which we will send a periodical newsletter on the state of art of the project and for the distribution of potential initiatives to be involved in .

The personal data collected will be processed by computer and during the time set by law or regulation, or in the absence of this, for the period strictly necessary for the pursuit of the purpose of the treatment.

HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR DATA?

Personnel who have access to your personal data understand the importance of keeping your information safe at all times and are instructed accordingly.

Each member of the “TWOST” Project Consortium is responsible for processing personal data under the Project in compliance with applicable EU and national law on data protection (including authorizations or notification requirements). If one Consortium member fails, the other Consortium members cannot be held responsible for their actions.

We are not responsible for the privacy policies and practices of other websites, even if you access them using links from our site, so we recommend that you check the privacy policy of each site you visit.

HOW DO WE STORE YOUR DATA?

Any personal data provided or stored on the IT Tools will be processed by the “TWOST” Project Consortium pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 as from its entry into force in May 2018.

WHAT ARE YOUR DATA PROTECTION RIGHTS?

You have:

- the right to access: you have to right to request TWOST Project Consortium for copies of your personal data
- the right to rectification: you have the right to request TWOST Project Consortium correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- the right to erasure: you have the right to request TWOST Project Consortium erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- the right to restrict processing: you have the right to request TWOST Project Consortium restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

- The right to object to processing: you have the right to object to TWOST Project Consortium' processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- the right to data portability: you have the request that TWOST Project Consortium transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
